Location of Parking Garages

2nd Street Garage: The 10-story, 1,000-space garage is located at 201 East 2nd Street, 2 blocks west of facility, between Cesar Chavez and 2nd Street. Entrances are on Brazos and San Jacinto streets.

5th Street Garage: The 5-story, 685-space garage is located at 601 E. 5th Street, the northeast corner of facility at Red River and 4th Street, with the entrance on 5th Street.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT: This written examination shall be held in accordance with the Agreement between the City of Austin and the Austin Police Association and with Civil Service law and rules, and shall be open to all sworn personnel who have had two years continuous active service as a Police Corporal/Detective immediately preceding the date of the written examination.

REGISTRATION FOR EXAMINATION: In accordance with Civil Service Rule 7.06, all eligible candidates desiring to take the examination **MUST** register by signing a Letter of Intent, by no later than 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday October 12th, 2010. Letters of Intent will be signed at the Civil Service Office, One Texas Center, 505 Barton Springs Road, Suite 600. **Only those applicants who have registered by signing a Letter of Intent will be admitted to the examination.**
